MINUTES OF CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN
HELD SEPTEMBER 21st, A. D. 1928.

Be it remembered that on this the 21st day of September A. D. 1928, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Hall thereof with the following members present, to-wit: Joe C. Denman, Commissioner Ward No.1, and acting Mayor protem; C. A. Burke, Commissioner Ward No.2; W. A. Abney, Commissioner Ward No.4; V. R. Smitham, City Manager; T. L. Dunn, City Secretary; and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were heard, to-wit:

It appearing to the City Commission that portion of one street, viz:

(a) Gain Street from its intersection with south line of Abney Avenue to its intersection with north line of Bremond Avenue, has been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date June 8th, A. D. 1928, and the acceptance of said street has been recommended in writing by City Engineer and City Manager, Mr. V. R. Smitham; on motion C. A. Burke, seconded by W. A. Abney, all voting yea, said street was accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvement on said street is now received and accepted by the City.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessments ordinance heretofore passed, a form of said assessment certificates being attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof, which form is in all respects approved.
