MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUF-  
KIN, TEXAS, HELD Sep. 24th,  
1928.

Be it remembered that on this the 24th day of September, A.D. 1928,  
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission, of the  
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the City Hall in said City, Present and presid-  
ing the following officers of the City:- J.W.Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Den-  
man, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2,  
W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4 (M.C.Spivey, Commissioner of Ward  
No. 3 being absent), V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City At-  
torney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings  
were had, to-wit:-

It being announced that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss  
the question of purchasing lots 4 and 5 in Block No. 22 from John Wootson  
and wife for a fire station site.

After a due and careful consideration of the matter of purchasing  
the property above described, and it being made known that said property  
could be purchased for the sum of \$4,000.00 cash, it was moved by W.A.  
Abney and seconded by Joe C. Denman that said property be purchased at  
the price stated. The motion having been put by the Mayor same carried  
by the following vote, to-wit:- Ayes- J.W.Hawkins, Joe C.Denman, C.A.  
Burke, and W.A.Abney. Noes- None- Whereupon the Mayor stated that the  
motion carried. It was further ordered that the Mayor be and is hereby  
authorized and to execute Warrants in the sum agreed upon for the pur-  
chase price of said property, and such amount is hereby appropriated out  
of the Fire Station Bond Fund for such purpose.
