MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD Dec. 3, 1929.

Be it remembered that on this the 3rd day of December, A. D. 1929, there was held a regular term of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City, with the following officers of the City present: C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, and Mayor Pro tem, presiding (Joe C. Denman, Mayor, being absent) C. E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W. D. Tiner, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings, read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

City Manager, W. D. Tiner asked permission to construct sewer lines as follows:- On Turner Street from Kerr Avenue to Pershing, then on Kerr Avenue to the main line crossing on same. Also a sewer on Hoskins Street from a point about 50 feet west of Clingman Street in an easterly direction a distance of 225 feet. The question having been duly considered by the Commission by move and second duly made and carried City Manager was instructed to proceed with the work aforesaid.

All bills and accounts due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and at appearing that said bills had been approved by the City Manager, on motion duly made and carried same were allowed.

Other matters pertaining the business of the City was discussed, but nothing of record done.

There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
