MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPT. 23rd,
1930.

Be it remembered that on this the 23rd day of September, A.D. 1930,
there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Luf-
kin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City, with the fol-
lowing officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The resignation of R. E. Henry as City Treasurer of the City of Luf-
kin, Texas, was presented for consideration of acceptance, and after read-
ing same to the City Commission same was accepted, effecting September 20th
1930.

City Manager W. D. Tiner reported the appointment of Carey Trevathan,
an employee of the First State Bank & Trust Company, which said Bank is
the City Depository for the City of Lufkin, as City Treasurer of said
City, such appointment to take effect at once. On motion of R. C. Jordan,
Seconded by C. E. Brazil, such appointment is hereby in all things con-
firmed.

It appeared that heretofore by agreement by and between the City
and Mrs Rosa Bonner that in consideration of the said Mrs. Rosa Bonner
deeding to the City certain right-of-way for the location of what is
now known as Highway No. ⁴⁰~~35~~, the city would deed to the said Mrs. Rosa
Bonner the old abandoned road lying just north of the old East Texas
Railroad and east of the present highway, and being land lying between
the present highway and property of J.V. Pinson, Joe Colwell and Emma
Berry. Therefore, on motion of C.E. Brazil seconded by C.A. Burke, it
is hereby ordered that the City Mayor, Joe C. Denman executed proper
quit-claim deed to the said Rosa Bonner for the land aforesaid.

R. O. Moore, through P.M. Albritton, having made application to lease
of City Lake property for purpose of drilling for oil, gas or other
minerals, and a form of lease having been prepared by City Attorney R.C.

Musslewhite and same having been read to the City Commission, it was moved by C.A. Burke and seconded by W.A. Abney that said form be approved and that the Mayor, Joe C. Denman, be authorized to execute said lease in the name of the City to the said R. O. Moore. The motion carried unanimously.

In connection with the matter of constructing curb on the Old Diboll Road from the end of the present pavement on Bynum Street to the City Limits, the City Manager asked for authority to ask for bids for such work. The city commission granted such authority.
