MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD SEPTEMBER 30th, 1931.

Be it remembered that on this the 30th day of September, A. D. 1931, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

Wm. A. Foster,	Mayor,
W. O. Greene,	Comms. Ward No. 1,
C. A. Burke,	Comms. Ward No. 2,
W. A. Abney,	Comms. Ward No. 4,
R. C. Musslewhite,	City Attorney, and
T. L. Dunn,	City Secretary.

R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent on account of sickness. A. F. Daniel, City Manager, was absent because the meeting held was for the purpose of considering the passage of an order removing him, the said A. F. Daniel, from the position of City Manager of the City of Lufkin.

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the question of issuing and entering an order of removal of City Manager A. F. Daniel.

The question as aforesaid, that of issuing and entering an order, removing A. F. Daniel as City Manager of the City of Lufkin, was carefully considered and discussed by the City Commission, after which it was moved by Commissioner W. A. Abney and seconded by Commissioner W. O. Greene, that an order be made, entered and issued, removing the said A. F. Daniel as City Manager of the City of Lufkin, said order to take effect October 31st, 1931. The question was put by the Mayor, he requesting those members of the City Commission who favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No"- The following vote is is here entered: "Ayes"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W. A. Abney. "Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the order issued)

It appearing that heretofore, on Sept 16th, 1931, an ordinance was passed on ~~second~~ ^{first} reading, providing for the borrowing of certain monies from the First State Bank & Trust Co of Lufkin, Texas, and that it is necessary to pass said ordinance on second reading, it was moved by C.A. Burke and seconded by W.A. Abney that said ordinance be passed on second and final reading. The motion carried unanimously. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the ordinance).
