Pursuant to written notice as appears herein the City Commission met in call session on this the 30th day of October, 1931, for the purpose of hearing certain written charges filed and heretofore presented to A. E. Daniel, City Manager and for the further purpose of acting upon such charges immediately upon hearing said charges and all parties, as provided for in Sec. 25 of the Special Charter of the City of Lufkin.

It was agreed that a stenographer, Mr. B.L.Collins, might make a stenographic report of the proceedings.

Charges were read by Mayor W. A. Foster. Exceptions and general demurer were read by Attorney R. W. Fairchild. After having heard the exceptions and general demurer read on motion made by W.O. Greene, seconded by C.A. Burke same were overruled. Proponent's answer on merits was read. Verbal general denial was made by City Attorney R.C. Musslewhite. Testimony was offered by both parties.

After having heard all the charges read, the exceptions and demurers etc read, and having heard all the evidence offered, and after duly considering same, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by W. A. Abney that the order of removal heretofore entered, be in all things confirmed, and that A.F. Daniel be removed from the office of City Manager effective from and after October 31st, 1931.

The Mayor put the question and the following is the vote as taken and is here entered of record in the minutes of the City Commission,

to-wit:- "Ayes" Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W. A. Abney.
"Noes"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried.

It appearing that it would be necessary to prepare written resolution to be entered in connection with the action as above shown taken, the meeting adjourned until 7:30 o'clock P.M. October 31st, 1931 at which time it is to meet back at the City Hall for further action in the above matter.

Pursuant to adjournment as above set forth, the City Commission met at the City Hall or Municipal Office in the City of Lufkin for the purpose of approving written resolution in connection with the removal of A.F. paniel as City Manager of the City of Lufkin.

A resolution having been prepared by the City Attorney showing the action of the City Commission in the matter of removing A.F. Daniel as City Manager of the City of Lufkin was read to the City Commission.

After having heard same read and having discussed the same and having fully understood the matters therein stated, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by W. A. Abney that said resolution confirming action of City Commission of City of Lufkin in removing A.F. Daniel from the office of City Manager of the City of Lufkin and declaring such office vacant and ordering said A.F. Daniel to discontinue his services as City Manager of the City of Lufkin from and after October 31st, A.D. 1931, be finally passed and approved by the City Commission of the City of Lufkin.

The Mayor put the question in due form and the following is the vote as taken and is here now entered upon the minutes of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, to-wit: "Ayes"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke, and W.A. Abney. "Noes"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution finally passed and approved.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved on this the 3rd day of November, A.D. 1931.
