MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,  
TEXAS, HELD JUNE 10th, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 10th day of May, A.D. 1932, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to adopt the 1932-33 City Budget. Notice of such meeting having been duly advertised in the Lufkin Daily News as provided by the Special Charter of the City of Lufkin, Texas, there were a goodly number of citizens of the City present to discuss the matter of adopting the budget as proposed and which had been published in the Lufkin Daily News. A general discussion of the different items in the budget was had; many questions being asked relative to same and the opinion being expressed by some spectators that same should be cut, but no place suggested to cut. One of the spectators did request that the item under General Government noted as "Parks" be raised to provide sufficient funds to take care of the City Park for the budget year. Such suggestion was acted upon favorably and it was ordered put in the budget. An item of \$125.00 which had heretofore been authorized to go in the budget to provide rental on Air Port site was also authorized put in. Finally discussion ceased and the Mayor called for a motion for action on the proposed budget. C. A. Burke made the motion that the budget as heretofore prepared and published with the addition of \$600.00 to the "Parks" and \$125.00 to Rental on Air Port be adopted. M. M. Jones seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the vote: "Ayes"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke, M. M. Jones and W. A. Abney. "Noes"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the budget finally adopted. (See page following for the budget as adopted.)
