MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE  
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY  
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD  
OCT. 22st, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 22st day of October A. D. 1932,  
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and  
for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City,  
with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:--

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:--

A report from the Y.M.C.A. organization as to the attitude of  
local School board relating to the building of an out-door gymnasium,  
in the City Park located near the Kurth Grammer School,  
was made, which was to the effect that said School Board was heartily  
in accord with such action, and would lend its aid toward making same  
a success. The City having heard the report and considered the matter  
themselves, it was moved by W. A. Abney and seconded by C.A. Burke  
that permission be granted to the Y.M.C.A. organization to construct  
an out-door gymnasium for general use by the citizenship of the City  
in the City Park near the Kurth Ward Grammer School, and the motion  
have been put by the Mayor, same carried unanimously. M. M. Jones  
and T. L. Dunn were appointed as a committee to represent the City and  
to meet with Mr. E.L. Corson, Secretary of the Y.M.C.A., at the City  
Park and select the place for construction said gymnasium.

A resolution providing that all interest and penalties that have  
accrued or that may accrue on ad valorem and poll taxes that are de-  
linquent on or before December 31st 1932 be released, provided said  
advalorem or poll taxes are paid on or before December 31st, 1932,  
was presented for passage and approval. W.A. Abney made the motion and  
M. M. Jones seconded same, that said resolution be passed and adopted.  
Same carried unanimously. (See another page of these minutes for a re-
