The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to pass a resolution authorizing and directing the City Attorney and City Manager to istitute condemnation proceedings against E. E. Turner and wife for the purpose of securing 10 feet of land from them, and which lies along the north side of Denman Avenue, for the purpose of widening said Denman Avenue to a width of 80 feet in order that the State Highway Department would take said Denman Avenue over for construction and maintenance, it being proposed to rout State Highway No. 40 over said Denman Avenue.

A resolution as aforesaid, was presented for passage and approval. Same was read to the City Commission. It was moved by Commissioner C.A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney that said resolution be passed and approved. The mayor having called for the vote on same, the following is recorded: "Ayes"— Wm.A.Foster, W.O.Greene, W.A.Burke, M.M.Jones and W.A. Abney. "Noes"— None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said resolution passed and approved.
