MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD MAY 24th, 1932.

Be it remembered that on this the 24th day of May, A.D. 1932, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was stated by the Mayor to discuss the question of entering an order granting to R. C. Chancey and H. C. Billingsly, Policemen, leave of absence without pay for a period of time, not less than two months, June 1st to July 31st, inclusive, for the reason that they are making the race for sheriff of Angelina County. C. A. Burke made ~~and~~ motion which was seconded by W. O. Greene, that leave of absence be granted to the said R.C. Chancey and H. C. Billingsley, effective June 1st, 1932, and to extend for a period of not less than two months. The motion carried unanimously.

Then came up for discussion the question of filling the vacancies ~~caused~~ by the absence of R.C.Chancey and H.C. Billingsly. The names of W. C. Turner and Tom Mantooth were submitted, together with many others. On recommendation by City Manager W.C. Turner and Tom Mantooth were chosen to work as policemen during the absence of the said R.C.Chancey and H.C. Billingley.

A claim of the Angelina Hatchery for damages claimed due to them by the City caused by the flooding of a building during a down pour of rain which casued several hundred chickens to drown was submitted for consideration. After discussion of the question it was unanimously ordered that the payment of said claim be refused, and that said Angelina Hatchery be so notified.
