MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
Nov. 16th, 1933.


A regular form Resolution prepared by the State Highway Department concerning the construction of Highway No. 35 through the City was introduced for passage and approval. Said resolution provides that the city agrees to refrain from permitting encroachments upon the right of way of said Street(First Street), and refrain from passing ordinances or laws fixing a speed limit of under twenty miles per hour on said Street agree to refrain from erecting signs, semaphores and signals that will give preference to local routes or that will hinder or delay traffic on said above named street.

On motion duly made and carried it was moved that such resolution be finally passed and approved, and that certification of same be made to the State Highway Department.
