The purpose of the meeting was to discuss further the preparation of the annual budget of the city and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

Discussion of the budget was entered into, but the inclusion of a few items that seemingly should be taken care of, was withheld until the regular meeting in June. Therefore final preparation of said budget was deferred until the June regular meeting.

Mr. Jean Shotwell, Manager of the Lufkin Telephone Company, appeared before the City Commission and filed with it a report or statement showing the Operating income and expesses in Lufkin and Keltys of said Company for the year 1932, such report being filed in accordance with a request for same by the City Commission some three or four months ago; it being the purpose of the City Commission to arrive at what profit is being made by the said Telephone Company, with the idea in mind that if the profits being made would justify it, an ordinance would be passed reducing the rates now being charged by said Telephone Company. Action on the passage of an ordinance reducing the rates was passed until the regular meeting in June.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carrined, it adjourned.
