## RESOLUTION.

Whereas, it has come to the knowledge of the City Commission that all deeds or title papers had been secured in connection with the right-of way for the Denman Avenue Extension from S. Raguet Street to S. First Street and that such title papers had been duly recordered in the County Clerk's Office, and

whereas, it further appearing that 14/14 that part of said Denman Avenue aforesaid is part of the designated Highway No. 40 through
the City of Lufkin, Texas, and it further appearing that the paving and
constructing of said Denman Avenue Extension has been done wholly by
the State Highway Department, it is the opinion of the this City Commission that title to said Denman Avenue Extension should be vested
in the State Highway Department, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN:

- 1. That the title to said Denman Avenue Extension, that is that part of Denman Avenue connecting from S. Raguet Street to S. First Street be vested in the State Highway Department of the State of Texas.
- 2. That the Mayor of the City of Lufkin, Texas, the Hon C. A. Burke, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed, passing title from the City of Lufkin, Texas to the State Highway Department of the State of Texas, said Denman Avenue Extension as aforesaid.
