Be it remembered that on this the 13th day of February, A.D. 1934, Commission there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City Present and presiding, to-wit:-

Adams the sum of \$150.00 for certain land for reight of way for the purpose of extending Denman Avenue, and that he had refused to accept same. That he had offered to the J.H.Moffett heirs, Mrs. Virgie Schuller and William Newbern in person and to the other heirs, Mrs Mattie English, Laura Hottle, Mable Whitehead, Mary Ayers and Bessie Bellamy, by wire that sum of \$250.00 for certain land for the purpose of extending Denman Avenue, and that they had refused to accept same, either by a direct refusal or by failing to reply to telegrams sent.

After hearing the above report there was introduced a resolution entitled "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LEFKIN DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO PROCEED WITH CONDEMNATION OF CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY BELONGING TO D.H. ADAMS AND WIFE, EMMIE ADAMS, FOR STREET PURPOSES FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, STATING NATURE AND EXTENT OF IMPROVEMENT TO BE MADE AND THE LIMITS THEREOF, AND DESCRIBING THE LAND TO BE CONDEMNED" was introduced for passage and approval.
