TEXAS, HELD APRIL 5th, 1935.

The purpose of the meeting was to pass an ordinance declaring the result of the regular general City Election which was held on the first Tuesday in April, 1935, same being the 2nd day of April, 1935, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1935, SAME BEING THE 2nd DAY OF APRIL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR FROM THE CITY AT LARGE AND A COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO 1, AND A COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO. 3, was introduced for final passage and approval/

Said ordinance was read to the City Commission and on motion made by D. A. Campbell, and seconded by W. A. Abney, that said ordinance be finally passed and approved, it was approved and passed by the following vote: Ayes- W.A. Greene, D.A. Campbell and W.A. Abney.
