1936.

Be it remembered that on this the 19th day of August, A. D. 1936, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, towwit:

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was stated to be to pass Ordinance canvassing returns and declaring result of Election held August 15th, 1936 for the purpose of electing a City Commissioner from Ward No. 3, to fill the unexpired term of D.A.Campbell, deceased, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting:

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN ON THE FIFTEENTH DAY OF AUGUST, A.D. 1936? FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO. THREE TO FILL THE UN-EXPIRED TERM OF D. A. CAMPBELL"

was introduced for passage and approval. W. O. Greene, Made a motion that said ordinance be read to the City Commission and that it be passed and approved. The motion was seconded by Lewis Hicks. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the ordinance)

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING THE NAMES OF TWO CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE OF CITY COMMISSIONER OF WARD NO. THREE RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES CAST AT ELECTION HELD AUGUST FIFTEENTH, 1936, PRESCRIBING QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTING AT SUCH ELECTION AND FIXING TIME AND PLACE OF HOLDING SUCH ELECTION, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION" was

introduced for passage and approval on first reading. Lewis Hicks made a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it be passed and approved on first reading. W. O. Greene seconded said motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks and J. E. Jay. "NOES"

None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CARNIVAL SHOWS, TENT SHOWS, SKATING RINKS, PUBLIC DANCE HALLS, WITHIN SIX HUNDRED FEET OF A PRIVATE RESIDENCE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR"

was introduced for passage and approval on first reading. W. O. Greene made a motion that the ordinance be placed on first reading and that it pass first reading. The motion was seconded by Lewis Hicks. The Mayor put the question and the following is recorded vote on the motion: "AYES" Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.
