MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION HELD AT THE CITY HALL IN LUFKIN, TEXAS, AUGUST 20th, 1936.

Be it remembered that on this the 20th day of August A.D. 1936, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers present, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

It was stated that the purpose of the meeting was to pass on second and final readings the following ordinances, to-wit: "An Ordinance calling a special election to elect a Commissioner from Ward No. 3" and "An Ordinance prohibiting Carnival Shows, Ten Shows, Skating Rinks and Public Dance Halls, within 600 feet of a private residence within the corporate limits of the City of Lufkin, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION WITH-IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING THE NAMES OF TWO CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE OF CITY COMMISSIONER OF WARD NO. THREE RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES CAST AT ELECTION HELD AUGUST FIFTEENTH, 1936, PRESCRIBING QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTING AT SUCH ELECTION AND FIXING TIME AND PLACE OF HOLDING SUCH ELECTION, ¢AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION" was introduced for passage and

approval on second and final reading. J. E. Jay made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it pass second and final reading. Lewis Hicks seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES" Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the orinance.)

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CARNIVAL SHOWS, TENT SHOWS, SKATING RINKS, PUBLIC DANCE HALLS, WITH-IN SIX HUNDRED FEET OF A PRIVATE RESIDENCE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. W.O. Greene made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it pass second and final reading. Lewiss Hisks seconded the motion. The following is the recorded vote on the motion, viz: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O.Greene, Lewis Hicks and J. E. Jay. "NOES"-None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the ordinance)
