MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD NOV. 15th, 1930.

Be it remembered that on this the 15th day of November, A.D. 1930, there was begun and holden a special call meeting of the City Commission at the City Hall in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding:— Joe C. Benman, Mayor, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Wrad No. 4, W. D. Tiner, (R.C. Jordan, Coms. Ward No. 3 being absent) City Manager and T. L. Bunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:—

The Mayor satated that the purpose of the meeting was to declare the office of City Commissioner of Ward No. 1 vacant, and to call a special election to be held in the City of Lufkin for the purpose of electing a City Commissioner from said Ward No. 1, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

It appearing that C. E. Brazil, the duly elected City Commissioner 1, from Ward No. of the City of Lufkin, Texas, has been appointed to the Office of District Judge for the second Judicial District of the State of Texas, thereby causing the vacancy in the position of City Commission sioner as aforesaid. It is therefore the order of this City Commission that the Office of City Commissioner of Ward No. 1 of the City of Lufkin, Texas, be and it is hereby declared vacant.

tion for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the position of Commissioner of Ward No. 1 of the City, Said vacancy being caused for the reason as above stated. On motion made by W.A. Abney and seconded by C.A. Burke it was unanimoularly carried that an ordenance be passed called a special election to be held in the City on the 26th day of November, A.D. 1930 for the purpose of elections a City Commissioner from Ward No. 1 of the City of Lufkin, Texas, to fill out the unexpired term of C.E. Brazil. (The ordinance appears at another page of these minutes)

It was move by W.A. Abney and seconded by C.A.Burke that and amount of \$50.00 be paid to the Volunteer Fire Department to cover expenses attending the District Firemen's Convention at Orange. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business by move and second duly made and carried she meeting adjourned.
