

MINUTES OF Special MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD February 25th, 1952, at 4:45 P. M.

On this the 25th day of February, 1952, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in Regular Session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: J. M. Snell
constituting a quorum when the following business was trans-
acted:

1 On Motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler, an alley running East and West from Homer Blvd., to Montrose Street in the blocks bounded on the North by Conn Avenue and on the South by Kerr Avenue was deeded to the ^{abutting} property, ^{owner} the City retaining a 10 foot easement. All voted "Aye".

2 Commissioner Stegall proposed that the City pay the \$31,800.00 note, plus interest, from General Fund; pay \$20,000.00, plus interest, from Sinking Fund on the \$30,000.00 Right-of-Way note, and pay the \$10,000.00 balance, plus interest, from General Fund. Commissioner Zeagler seconded the motion and all voted "Aye."

3 City Attorney Brazil presented a resolution correcting a Right-of-Way deed. The Commission voted acceptance of the resolution on motion of Commissioner Treadwell, second by Commissioner Zeagler.
