1. The special meeting was called to order by Mayor  
Woodrow W. Scott who stated that the purpose of such meeting  
was to canvass the election returns on the water and sewer  
revenue bonds held on September 15th, 1955. The Presiding  
Election Judge made his returns to the City Commission and  
upon canvassing such returns, the result of the bond election  
was declared as follows:

Proposition No. 1: For - 403 Votes  
Against - 82 Votes  
Proposition No. 2: For - 393 Votes  
Against - 78 Votes  
Proposition No. 3: For - 392 Votes  
Against - 82 Votes .

2. Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
