MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE

TEXAS, HELD JANUARY 7th, A.D. 1938.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Mr. G. H. Atkinson appeared in person and made protest as to the value placed on his property for City Tax purposes for the year 1937, and requested that it be adjusted. His plea and argument was heard, after which the Mayor appointed a committee composed of himself, W. D. Winston, Jr., and C. L. Hicks to visit his property and compare values of his properties with other properties of a similar character and location, and to instruct the City Tax Collector what to do in the premises.
