1. The minutes of meeting held November 3, 1953 were read and approved.

2. Mr. Wilber Kent presented preliminary plans for Fire Station to be erected at Ellis and Bynum Streets. Mr. Kent was instructed to prepare final plans and secure bids on Fire Station and present same to the Commission for final approval or disapproval.

3. On motion of Commissioner Gipson, seconded by Commissioner Nerren, all voting Aye, Mayor W. W. Scott, was appointed Acting City Manager for a period of 10 days, in the absence of Acting City Manager Joe McClendon.

4. The Commission authorized sending a clerk for the Police Dept. Traffic Bureau to Austin for a period of two weeks training.

5. The Commission voted to postpone the erection of street markers throughout the city until after first of ~~April~~ in 1954, Motion by Comm. Collins, Seconded Comm. Nerren, "Yea" Collins, Nerren, Brittain, "No" Gipson.

6. Voted unanimously to pay all bills for the month of October as presented.

There being no further business the meeting duly adjourned.
