- 1. The meeting was opened with a prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
- 2. The minutes of the regular meeting held on May 3 were read and approved.
- 3. Zone application of Curtis Fenley and R. C. Mussle-white, to change the Zone to "H" District on what is known as the Freeman Property on Timberland Drive, was heard and such change was granted as requested.
- 4. The request of the Summer Recreation Committee of the Chamber of Commerce for participation in the summer program was discussed. Commissioner Collins was again designated as a representative of the City to work with the Committee, and the City agreed to co-operate and participate in such recreational program.
- 5. The offer of Pat McCann to settle his claim for water mains used in the Broadmore Addition, for \$5,000.00 was rejected.
- 6. The Safety Council of the Chamber of Commerce was to be contacted and it was agreed to co-operate with them in every way in removing traffic hazards at street intersections within the City.
- 7. The City Commission adopted Employees Manual for the use and benefit of employees of the City.

- \$. It was agreed to obtain estimates for the repairs of the City Lake.
- 9. Tentative approval of proposed lighting of the streets in the down-town area and on Lufkin Avenue was adopted.
- 10. The Commission received the report of the Zoning Board recommending zone change from "A" to "E" upon the application of Mrs. Lillian Clark Cooper on Lots No. 4, 5, and 6 in Block No. 6 of the Woodland Heights Addition to the City of Lufkin, and final hearing on such application was ordered published, and such final hearing to be held at the regular meeting on June 7, 1955.
 - 11. Bills for the month of April were approved.
