It was maintained by the City of Lufkin that his place of buisness was in the City limits, and that he maintained and office in the City Limits of the City of Lufkin, and that the property assessed, (trucks) were in the city limits the greater part of the time, hence property to render and pay taxes on such equipment. The matter could not be determined at the meeting, but was referred to City Attorney, Curtis W. Fenley and City Tax Attorney, C. D. Jessup, Jr. for attention and recommendation.
