there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of  
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said city with the

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

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Minutes of meetings held during the month of December 1936, were  
read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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Bids having been called for and duly advertised for the furnishing  
of  
of labor and tools only for the costruction a wood cover over one of the  
clear weels at the City Water Plant, two bids were received as follows:

The two bids having been considered and discussed, it was moved by  
Lewis Hicks and Seconded by J. B. Perry that contract be awarded to J.B.  
Yarbrough, he being the lowest bidder. The Mayor put the question and  
the motion carried unanimously.

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The position of City Health Officer being vacant on account of the  
death of Dr. R.T.Canon, it became necessary to appoint a suitable person  
to fill such position. Two applications for said position were received,  
one from Dr. Robert W. Taylor and One from Dr. Denman C. Hucherson. Hucher-  
son received four votes, Hoskins, Greene, Perry and Jay. Taylor received  
one vote, Lewis Hicks. Dr. Denman C. Hucherson was delcared elected.  
See resolution in these minutes making the appontment and recording the  
oath of office.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion  
duly made and carried, it adjourned.
