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1 The purpose of the meeting was to read and approve current bills due various parties and concerns, and to act on any other matter that might come before the council.

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2 The current bills were read and discussed. C. C. Sinclair made motion that council allow bills to be paid, D. M. Thrash seconded the motion. The Mayor put motion to vote. All voted "Aye". "Noes" None.

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3 The matter of Highway 94 in the City Limits came up for discussion, and in view of the High cost of R/W and the property owners protest for the routing of same on Frank Avenue. Motion was made by C. C. Sinclair, and seconded by G. W. Roland, that Texas State Highway Dept., be notified that Ellis Avenue to the Intersection of Cotton Square be designated as Continuation of Highway 94., Mayor put motion to vote. All Voted "Aye" "Noes" None.
