MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
March 2nd, 1937.

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of March, A. D. 1937, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of all meetings held during the month of February, 1937 were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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J. W. Lawless, a tax paying citizen of the City of Lufkin, appeared before the City Commission and stated that he was about to be sued for delinquent City Taxes, and that he wished to make satisfactory arrangements with the City to pay such delinquent taxes and avoid being sued. After hearing his plea and it appearing that he had paid current City taxes promptly and it further appearing that the payment of \$5.00 per month to apply on delinquent taxes would be satisfactory to the city, and the said J. W. Lawless agreeing to make such payment, he was promised that no suit would be filed on condition that the said amount of \$5.00 per month would be paid each month until all delinquent City Taxes have been paid.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME LIMIT FOR REQUESTS FOR NAMES TO GO ON THE OFFICIAL BALLOT FOR THE REGULAR ELECTION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, KIND AND MANNER OF REQUEST, AND ORDER OF NAMES TO APPEAR ON BALLOT."

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. Commissioner Lewis Hicks made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it pass second and final reading. The motion was seconded by Commissioner J. E. Jay. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks, J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS AND TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE, FROM PLYING THEIR TRADE IN AND UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR", was introduced for

passage and approval on second and final reading. Commissioner J. B. Perry made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading, and that it pass second and final reading. Commissioner Lewis Hicks seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks, J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF THE GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1937, ~~SAME BEING THE 6th DAY OF APRIL, 1937~~, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR FROM THE CITY AT LARGE AND TWO CITY COMMISSIONERS, ONE FROM WARD NO. ONE AND ONE FROM WARD NO. ~~TWO~~ was introduced for passage and approval. Commissioner Lewis Hicks made a motion that said ordinance be read to the City Commission and that be passed and approved. The motion was seconded by W. O. Greene. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks, J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved.

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A Resolution entitled "RESOLUTION AND ORDER BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, REVOKING THE "MASTER ELECTRICIAN'S LICENSE" OF W. S. PAGE, FOR HIS FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, REGULATING ELECTRICAL WIRING" was introduced for passage and approval.

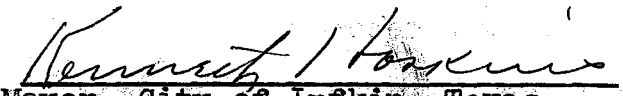
