MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE

Feb. 7th. 1933.

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of February A.D. 1933, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of meetings held during the month of January, A. D. 1933, were read, and motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

A petition having heretofore been filed with the City Commission asking that an ordinance be passed reducing the telephone rates as now being charged by the Lufkin Telephone Exchnage, and the said Telephone Exchange having been cited relative to said petition, and asking them to appear before the City Commission on this date, representatives of the said Telephone Company did appear and in answer to the question as to what their attitude would be regarding a reduction in said rates, stated that they were not position to state whether they would be willing to agree to a reduction in said rates at this time or not, because they did not have available complete inventories, lists etc. of the said telephone Company's propertys, and a complete audit of the books and records of same, so that it could be determined what percent, if any, was being made on the investment, and requested that they be given ninety (90) days time from this date, February 7th, 1933, in which to have prepared all data necessary to determine whether or not they would be willing to agree to a reduction. It was moved by W.A. Abney and seconded by C.A. Burke, that such time as asked for (90 days) be granted. The motion carried unani-
mously.
