1 Minutes of all meetings held during the month of December, 1943 were read and regularly approved.

2 Hearing ~~was called~~ on application of Pat Nesbitt for change of Zone District from "A" to "F" on a lot at the corner of Everitt and Paul was called for by the Mayor and the Secretary read a ~~protest~~ that had been filed by a number of property owners in that vicinity.

After discussion, motion was made by Jas. A. Abney, second by B.F. Milligan and carried by all members voting yea refusing to ~~change~~ make the change.

3. Hearing was called on application of A.M. Gould for change in Zone District from "B" to "J" on Lots No. 1 & 2 in Block No. 3 of North Montrose Addition.

There was no objection made to this change and after discussion motion was made by Arthur Temple, Jr., second by B.F. Milligan and carried by all members, voting yea that the change be made as requested. *except R. L. Melvin & W. L. Glenn who vote nay*

4 W. F. Jones requested the Commission to help him get permit from the C.D.T. for operating additional Taxi Cabs but there seemed to be nothing appropriate the Commission could do and no action was taken.

Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
