Be it remembered on this the 6th. day of June A. D. 1922 there was begun and helden A regular meeting of the City Commission of the city of Lufkin at the Municipal Office thereof: present and presiding E. E. Woods Mayor Pre tem, S. R. Parker Commissioner Ward #1 B. L. Zeagler Commissioner Ward #3 and W. B. Treadwell Commissioner Wards #4 C. N. Humason City Manager, C.H.Rice City Secretary W. O. Seale City Attorney, ~~and~~ the following preceedings were had to wit:

Bill of J. P. Sullivan for one hog claimed to have been killed by Pound Master J. M. Mills for the sum of \$100.00 was refered to City Manager Humason and City Attorney Seale for final action.

All accounts and bills due by the city of Lufkin to varieus parties firms and corporations for supplies etc. were presented for payment, and it appearing that all of said bills that have been properly audited and allowed by the City Manager should be paid, it is ordered that same be paid.

The account of Halloway White for damages incurred on land owned by said Halloway white where the back water from the City Reservoir ~~ever~~ spred ever was refered to City Manager Humason for adjustment.

Petition of practically all citizens living on Kaiser Street wishing the name of said street changed to the name of Montrose being presented, by vote and second duly made same carried unanimously to change the name of Kaiser Street to Montrose Street.

Ordinance Amending Article 2 & 3 of Ordinance #25 pertaining to the Plumbing and Supervising board of the City of Lufkin being read moved by Parker seconded by Treadwell to adopt same, same having been submitted by vote to the city Commission, same carried unanimously.

Ordinance regulating traffic across Railroad crossings being read before the City Commission by move and second duly made and carried same carried unanimously.

There being no futher business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment was taken.
