# MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD DECEMBER 1st, 1921.

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to consider proposals heretofore made by the American La-France Fire Engine Company, and the Stutz Fire Engine Company, to sell to the City of Lufkin, Texas, a 750 g.p.m. pumper.

After due and deliberate consideration of the proposals made by the two companies above mentioned, it was move by Commissioner E. E. Woods, and seconded by Commissioner B. L. Zeagler, that the City of Lufkin inter into contract with the American LaFrance Fire Engine Company for the purchase of one Type 75 Tripple Combination pumper of 750 g.p.m. capacity, to be equipped with pneumatic tires and other necessary equipment to make said machine actually ready for service when delivered, and to accept the terms of said American LaFrance Fire Engine Co. in the manner of payment for same, Cowit: One-fifth cash, April 15th, 1922, and the balance in four equal annual payments with interest at the rate of 6% per annum. Deferred payments to be evidenced by notes bearing date of April 15th, 1922, and to read payable on or before due dates. The Mayor put the question, and requested those who favord the purchase of the above described type of Fire Fighting Aparatus to vote "Aye" and those who opposed to vote "No". The following members of the City Commission voted "Aye", G. A. Kelley, S. R. Parker, E. E. Woods, B. L. Zeagler and W. B. Treadwell. The following members voted "No", None.
