MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY

TEXAS, HELD MARCH 25th, 1935.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was stated to be to provide for the calling of the General City Election to be held the First Tuesday in April 1935, and to do and perform any other matters that might properly come before the meeting.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF THE GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, 1935, SAME BEING THE 2nd DAY OF APRIL, 1935, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR FROM THE CITY AT LARGE AND TWO CITY COMMISSIONERS, ONE FROM WARD NO. 1, AND ONE FROM WARD NO. 3,

was introduced for passage and approval. D. A. Campbell made a motion that it be passed and approved. The motion was seconded by Louis Hicks. The following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- C.A.Burke, W. O. Greene, Louis Hicks, D.A. Campbell and W.A. Abney. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved.
