

being present, and the following absent:
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Mayor Glenn announced the purpose of the meeting was for Public Hearing on the proposed City Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning April 1st 1944 and ending March 31st 1945, as published in the Lufkin Daily News on June 14th 1944.
2. No one appeared to offer objection or amendment to the Budget and on motion of Jas. A. Abney, second by Arthur Temple, Jr., and carried by all members voting yea, the budget was adopted as published.
3. Mr. Lewis reported that what is known as the No. 2 water well located right near the City Water Pumping Plant had caved in and that request had been made of Layne-Texas Company for their opinion as to whether it would be most practical to try to save the old well by working it over or to put down a new well near by in the same sand, and an estimate of the cost both ways.
4. Regular meeting date for July coming on July 4th, it was decided to have the meeting ~~Friday~~ ^{Tuesday} evening July 7th at 3:30 PM.

There was no further business presented and the meeting adjourned.
