
MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS
HELD JANUARY 24th, A. D. 1928.

Be it remembered that on this the 24th day of January, A.D.1928, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City; Present and presiding J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, A.M.Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary. (Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 and M.C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 were absent). The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting as announced by the Mayor was to receive and open bids for the construction of a fire station at the corner of Third Street and Shepherd Avenue.

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The following bids were received and opened:-

Berry Construction Company,	Lufkin, Texas.-	\$22,980.00
Wm. A. Foster,	Lufkin, Texas.-	23,606.49
Leaverton & Walling,	Grapeland, Texas	24,385.00
Campbell & White,	Cooper, Texas,	21,557.00

After examination of said bids and after due and deliberate con-

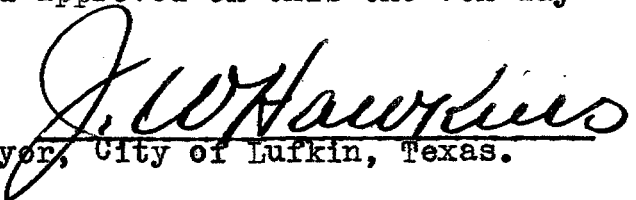
sideration of the same, it was moved by A. M. Walker and seconded by E. W. Leach that the contract be awarded to Campbell and White of Cooper, Texas, they being the lowest and best bid, on condition that the Fire Station is built on what is known as the Tyler Hotel lot at the corner of Third Street and Shepherd Avenue. The motion carried unanimoously.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
