

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY OF
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD ON NOVEMBER 9th, A.D. 1948 at 7:30
O'Clock P.M.

On this the 9th day of November, A.D. 1948, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in a called meeting in the City Hall in said City with the following members, thereof-to-wit:

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1. Mr. Jack Gordon and Sam Hartman, Volunteer Firemen, were present in regard to getting permission for placing Advertisements on Parking Meters for the benefit of Volunteer Firemen's Fund. Council advised them that City Attorney would check City Ordinance in Regard to Signs and let them know about it.

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2. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that all bills due various parties and concerns be allowed and paid. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" "NOES" NONE.

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3. Zone change application of E. J. Conn and Cecil E. Anderson from district "C" to "F" on part of Lot 6 Block 29 of the Denman addn. was discussed with Mr. Corbett Jordon, and action was deferred on same.

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4. Mr. Early discussed the delivery date on street sweeper that city had ordered, and the delivery on another make that he could possibly get sooner for a little more money. He was advised to wait until December 15th, 1948 before taking any action.

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5. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that Zone change application of Mrs. Clyde Furman be granted sinze same was properly advertised for public hearing On lot 1 Block 1 of the Vinson Addn. from "A" to "B" District., and no one appearing before council to protest change of zone. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" "Noes" None.

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6. A motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin that zone change request of Ashley Stroud on E. 1/2 of Tract 8, Map 3, corner of Abney and N. First be granted, since same had been properly advertised for public hearing, and no one appearing against it. Mayor put motion to a vote. "all voted "AYE". "NOES" None.

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7 A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash, that zone change application of Judson N. Coward on Tract 7 map 20, J. L. C. League from Zone "E" to "G" be granted, since same had been properly advertised and no one appearing against same. Mayor put motion to a vote. "All voted "AYE". "noes" None.

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8 Zone change application of James H. Butler on Lots 1 & 2 Block 32 of the N. Lufkin Addn. from "F" to "H" for the purpose of constructing a Negro Theatre was deferred.

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9 Council agreed to place a price of \$6,750.00 on the House purchased from Mrs. Floyd Fuller, and purchaser to move same at his or her expense.

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10 A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that travelling expense to Tyler in the amount of \$37.50 be allowed and paid O. C. Hanks. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" "NOES" NONE.

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11 Milk Ordinance and Inspection Fees were discussed, and Mr. Hanks advised council that he would check into what other towns were doing in regard to same, and work out something with Mr. Brazil.

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12 There being no further business to come Before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
