

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUTKIN,
KIM, TEXAS, HELD DEC. 6TH, 1927.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of December, A. D. 1927

there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lutkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said city; Pres-

ent and presiding the following officers, to-wit:- J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. E. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, H. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Beach, Commis-

sioner of Ward No. 4, V. E. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City At-
torney and E. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings
were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read and on motion made and carried
were approved as read.

A number of citizens appeared and made protest against the build-
ing of a garbage incinerator on the city's property south of the city,
and said citizens were informed that careful consideration would be
given in proposition as to location before final action was made to
construct a garbage incinerator at any point.

There came up for discussion and consideration the question of in-
forcing what is known as the "Snow Ordinance" of the city, or whether
it should be repealed. After discussion of the question it was passed
without action and for further consideration.

Accounts and bills due by the city to various parties, firms and
corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such of
said bills as had been properly approved by the city manager as provided
by the city charter of said city, on motion duly made and carried same
were allowed and the City Secretary instructed to issue warrants in pay-
ment of same.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on
motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
