An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION TWO OF A CERTAIN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE FIRE LIMITS AND REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, AND REMOVAL OF BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF LFUKIN, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES TOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF"
