Walker, and the Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss a proposition pertaining to the request of The Lufkin Foundry & Machine Company for a permit to construct a small push car track across S. Raguet Street from their property to Block one of the Trout Addition, for the purpose of carting away slag etc, from their plant. After due consideration of the question it was moved by Leach, and seconded by Denman that an ordinance be passed granting to the Lufkin Foundry & Machine Company such privilege.
