sented by Mr. Kelley and approval recommended.


2. On motion by B.F. Milligan, second by R.E. Melvin, all mem-
bers voting yea, the bills were approved for payment.

3. Motion was made by R.E. Melvin, second by Arthur Temple, Jr.
that ordinance approving the 1943-44 Budget be passed on
second and final reading.

The motion carried by all members
voting yea.


4. Mr. Kelley reported the fans offered for sale by Judson
Coward were not suitable for use by the City and without
formal action he was authorized to purchase such fans as
needed elsewhere.

meeting was adjourned.
