When the following proceedings, among others, were had, to-wit:

The purpose of the meeting as explained by the Mayor being to discuss the situation of this city occasioned by the present epidemic of meningitis and to consider the advisability of establishing a quarantine against those places where the epidemic is prevalent - and to transact such other business <sup>as may properly</sup> ~~as may properly~~ be done before the council.

After a free digest of the matter by the City Health officer, Dr. R. B. Beeson, he recommended the free enforcement of all the sanitary ordinances and the free use of lime on all premises -

He also advised that immediately he would demand that all public places of worship and amusement be closed - that he had already had the schools in this district closed indefinitely.
