1 The purpose of this meeting was to officially appoint members of a Board of Equalization for the City of Lufkin and to interview and select a City Manager.

2 The following named persons,

H. H. Dixon  
V. V. Crocker  
R. L. Weeks

were appointed as members of the Board of Equalization for the City of Lufkin, Texas for the year 1950. Motion was made by Joe Stegall that these men constitute the Board of Equalization for the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1950, Seconded by L. B. Zeagler, All voted Aye.

3 After interviewing applicants for the position of City Manager of the City of Lufkin, it was decided that Mr. Harry Steenson, present City Manager of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, be appointed to the position of City Manager for the City of Lufkin. The salary to be paid Mr. Steenson was set at \$7200.00 per year.

4 Motion made to appoint Mr. Steenson as City Manager was made by J. M. Snell and seconded by L. B. Zealger, with the understanding that he would assume his duties within thirty days. All voted "aye".

5 Motion was made by J. M. Snell and seconded by L. B. Zealger that the regular meeting days be changed to the first and third Tuesdays with meetings set for 7:30 P. M. The first Tuesday will be a business meeting and the third Tuesday of each month will be devoted to visitors and outside business. These dates to become effective October 1, 1950.
