

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD AUGUST 18, 1953 AT 7:30 P.M.

On Thisthe 18th day of August, A.D., 1953, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin convened in regular session at the regular meeting place in said City with the following members thereof being present:

1. The minutes of special meeting held August 11th, 1953, were read and approved.

2. Mrs Mae Griffin who resides at LotusLane and Bowers Street reported to the Commission that members of the Police Department had shot her dog, and she had asked Chief Powell to pay her the sum of \$125.00. She was advised that an investigation of Police records would be made and City Manager would report to her.

3. Dr. Gail Medford reported to the Commission, the financial condition of the Kurth Memorial Library. Dr. Medford told the Commission that the Library was operating at a loss on the \$250.00 per month received from the City and funds received from other sources. On motion by Mr. Gipson, seconded by Mr. Collins, all voting Aye, The commission supplemented the budget by an additional \$50.00 per month, beginning August, 1953, for the Library. This amount making a yearly total of \$3600.00.

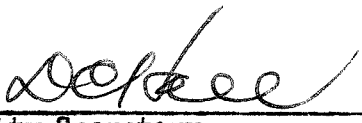
4. The Commission voted to recall Mr. John Redditt and Mr. S. W. Henderson, Jr. for a rehearing on water line extension granted them, from Two Point area and connecting with their two inch line serving them from the Houston Highway.

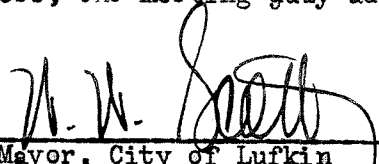
5. Commission opened sealed bids on tractor and mower attachment as follows:
