

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD JANUARY 5th, 1926.

Be it remembered that on this the 5th day of January, A. D. 1926, there was begun and helden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when, amon other things, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried were adopted as read.

Dr. J. C. VanNuys and N.R. Miller appeared before the City Commission as representatives of the Y.M.C.A. and asked that rent being charged the Y.M.C.A. be remitted; this being for office rent in the City Hall. After discussion of the question on motion made by E.W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Denman, that no charge be made for office rent from and after January 1st, 1926, so long as said office will not be needed for City use. The motion carried unanimously.

A. P. Johnson appeared before the City Commission and requested that certain improvements be made on Peyton Street by widening same. City Manager was instructed to investigate and if it was found that such improvements were needed and in his opinion should be made, to proceed with such improvements.

Applications by the following persons for license to operate service cars in the City were presented for consideration as follows:- Bert Pruitt, two cars; Geo. Lee, 3 cars; C. D. Thomas, one car; Perry & Means, two cars; Tom McKinney, one car; Robt. Denum, one car; J. R. Hawkins, one car; A. H. Goodson, one car; W. E. Nunnelee, one car; Sherwood Vinson, three cars; A. G. Perry, five cars. After due consideration of said applications, it was moved by A. M. Walker and seconded by Joe C. Denman, that all of said applications, except one by Bert Pruitt, which named Lidy Prewitt as driver, be approved. The one of Bert Prewitt above named is disapproved until suitable driver is named. Motion carried unanimously.

City Manager, C. N. Rumsen, reported the appointment of H. B. Satterfield as City Fire Marshal to succeed W. L. Jones, resigned. On motion duly made and carried said appointment was in all things confirmed.
