Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to discuss with Mr. L.F.Troxel, representative of the Natural Gas & Fuel Company of Brownwood, Texas, the question of granting to him a gas franchise in the City of Lufkin, Texas.

The matter was gone into thoroughly and a form of Franchise was discussed but no decision was reached about the matter and the meeting adjourned for further consideration and to meet again to consider the granting a franchise to the said L. F. Troxel.
