- 1. The minutes of the Commission meeting of April 15th were approved as read, motion by Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Nerren.
- 2.A request by Alex Andrews to repurchase property sold by him to the City for Right-of-way purposes was approved.
- 3. The zone change application requested by J. C. Koch and advertised, was given final approval on motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Nerren.
- 4. The Commission requested the City Manager and the City Attorney to investigate a charge made by George Jones that the Police were interfering with his right to work as a taxicab operator.
- 5. The Commission requested the City Manager to inquire of Brownie's Taxi the reasons for refusal to comply with the new taxicab ordinance.
- 6. On recommendation of Mayor Wright the Commission approved summer water rates to be effective with the billings of July lst, August lst, September 1, and October lst, on motion of Commissioner Nerren, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.
