

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE

HELD JULY 2nd, 1935.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of all meeting held during the month of June, 1935, were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

City Secretary was instructed to call for bids for selection of Depository as provided by Charter.
