Pursuant to notice herein the commission held a special meeting and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

An ordinancee entitled "AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LFUKIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF SEVEN EUROPED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$722,500.00) DOLLARS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING, CANCELLING AND IN LIEU OF A LIKE AMOUNT OF VALID AND SUBSISTING INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF THE REFUNDING BONDS AND THE FORM OF INTEREST COUPONS; LEVYING A DIRECT CONTINUING ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID CITY TO PAY THE INTEREST ON SUCH REFUNDING BONDS AND TO CREATE A SINKING FUND FOR THE REDEMTION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF SUCH TAX; AND ENACTING PROVISIONS INCIDENT AND NECESSARY TO THE SUBJECT AND PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE"

was introduced for passage and approval on first reading. Commissioner
Greene made a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and
that it pass first reading. Commissioner Perry seconded the motion. The
following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES" Kenneth Hoskins,
W. O. Greene, Lewis Hicks, J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and said ordinance passed and
approved on first reading.
