MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON SEPTEMBER 4, 1945 AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the 4 day of September, 1945, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in regular session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: E. A. Gibbs constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

Minutes of the regular meeting held August 7, 1945, were read and approved.

After a brief discussion it was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan, that a revolving Fund of \$3000.00 (Three Thousand Dollars) be set up and used in connection with the Typhus Control Program, and that, all moneys collected in connection with this Program

shall go back into this Fund. The motion was carried unanimously.

3 Mr. Robert Denum was present and asked if the City had any Warehouse space for rent. He also asked permission to install a set of commercial scales in the Alley at the rear of Lot 1, Block 26, of the Original Townsite of Lufkin. Mr. Denum was told that the City did not have any warehouse space for rent and that action on installation of the scales would have to be deferred until further investigation could be made.

The purchase of a Ditching Machine by the City was discussed but no definite action was taken concerning the matter.

A petition signed by a number of County Citizens requesting the

removal of the City Disposal Plant was read by Mr. Lewis.
Motion was made by B. F. Milligan and seconded by J. A. Abney, to approve the 1945 Tax Roll as recommended by the Board of Equalization. The motion was carried unanimously.

7. Mr. Lewis was authorized to sell to Mr. F. L. Calloway the property owned by the City, located at the intersection of North Angelina and Jackson streets.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
