MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD NOV. 4th, 1930.

Be it remembered that on this the 4th day of November, A.D. 1930,
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City,
with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-
Joe C. Denman, Mayor, C. E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke,
Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4,
Wayne D. Tiner, City Manager, R. C. Musslewhite, City Attorney, T. L.
Dunn, City Secretary, (R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 being ab-
sent), when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of all former meetings of the City Commission read and ap-
proved on motion duly made and carried.

The question of re-paving or topping of Zeagler Avenue was duly
discussed; Jno S. Redditt a property owner on said street was present
and made a proposition that if the City would do the work, and did not
have the money to finances same, that he would loan the city the money.
The Commission decided that the proposition of Mr. Redditt was a good
one, and on motion made by C. A. Burke, seconded by W. A. Abney, it was
unanimously carried that the said Zeagler Avenue be re-paved or re-
topped, the property owners on said street or owning property on said
street to pay one-half the entire cost of paving same and the City to
pay one-half of said cost.

A representative of J. Doug Morgan show Company appeared before
the City commission and asked permission to show in the City under the
auspices of the Fire Department. After discussing same it was carried
that such permission be not granted, because to do so would be in
violation of a City Ordinance relating thereto.

Accounts and bills were presented for payment, and it appearing
that such of said bills as had been approved for payment by the City
Manager should be paid by move and second duly made and carried same
were ordered paid.

There being no further business to come before the meeting by
move and second duly made and carried same adjourned.
