Melvin that the ordinance be passed on second and final reading.

Mr. Kelley reported that the County Hospital authorities had declined the offer the City Commission had made to rent the property owned by the City on Denman Avenue to them and it was agreed that the City Manager proceed to advertise the property for sale as had been planned before the Hospital Nurse's Home burned a few days before.
